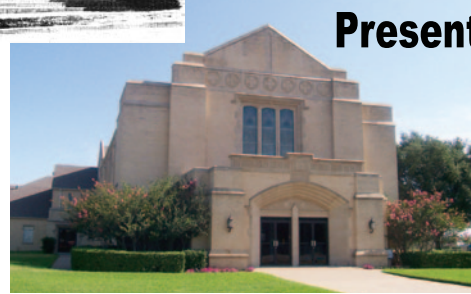

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS...

How does *Faith for the Future* work?

Each church member will be asked to commit to a sacrificial pledge over a three-year period. This commitment should be above and beyond your tithe and other commitments to the church.

How much are we trying to raise?

The projected cost of the renovations and parking lot improvements is \$450,000. We are trying to raise at least that amount.

Is everyone expected to give?

Everyone is asked to pray and seek God's leadership. Their participation is entirely between God and them. It is our sincere hope that this will be a united effort to carry out God's will for Gambrell Street Baptist Church.

What should I give?

Only God can answer this question for you. Our theme for the **Faith for the Future** campaign is "Not Equal Giving but Equal Sacrifice." Each commitment made in accordance with God's will is of equal importance to our effort. Through prayer, seek God's will about your commitment and follow his direction.

How will the commitments be made?

Beginning September 12, 2011, Harvest Team members will mail each family a commitment card. You will be asked to complete the card, seal it in the provided envelope, and bring it to the church.

Who will be tracking our individual progress in meeting our commitment?

The church's financial secretary will be the only one who will see the amount of your pledge.

Can we change the amount of our commitment after we've started giving?

Yes. If for any reason you want to increase or decrease the amount of your pledge, simply notify the church office.

How do we make our payments to *Faith for the Future*?

Our offering envelopes have a place to designate your regular offering plus your donations to **Faith for the Future**.
